

Directions to Burr Oak State Park Group Camp area

Note: this route isn't the shortest, but it's the fastest. Only about 12 miles on backroads.

About 90 miles, total drive time 2:30 with one pit stop (recommended in Nelsonville).

Take I-71 South to I-270 East/South to S.R. 33 East toward Lancaster.

Go through Lancaster and Nelsonville. On the far edge of Nelsonville find S.R. 78; look for a BP station at a traffic light. **Turn left onto S.R. 78.**

Go about 4 miles to the small town of Buchtel. In Buchtel, **turn right onto S.R. 685**; the intersection is well marked.

Follow S.R. 685, which has lots of twists and turns, including a very sharp left turn. In about 5 miles find S.R. 13. **Turn left onto S.R. 13.**

Go through the several very small towns, including Jacksonville, and through the larger town of Glouster. S.R. 13 is the "main drag" of Glouster. Just past Glouster is S.R. 78; you will see brown and white signs for the state park lodge. **Turn right onto S.R. 78.**

Go about 5 miles, passing the entrance to the lodge and cabins. Find County Rd. 14; look for a sign on the left that says **DOCK 3** -- this is an easy sign to miss! **Turn left on County Rd. 14.** and follow it until it dead-ends, then turn left for the Group Camp area.
